



## **Depression Medication Table**

Medication Name	Dose Schedule	Side Effects
Fluoxetine (Prozac) For ages 8 and older	Start daily test dose for 1-2 weeks of 5 mg for age 12 or 10 mg for age 12+	<b>Common:</b> nausea, insomnia, drowsiness, dry mouth, weight changes, sexual dysfunction
	If test dose tolerated, increase to target daily dose of 10 mg for< age 12 or fluoxetine 20 mg for age 12+	<b>Uncommon:</b> increased anxiety, sweating, tremors, diarrhea <b>Rare:</b> suicidal ideation, worsening depression, agitation, mania
Escitalopram (Lexapro) For ages 12 and older	Start daily test dose for 1-2 weeks of 5 mg for age 12+ If test dose tolerated, increase to target daily dose of 10 mg for age 12+	<ul> <li>Common: nausea, insomnia, drowsiness, dry mouth, weight changes, sexual dysfunction</li> <li>Uncommon: increased anxiety, sweating, tremors, diarrhea</li> <li>Rare: suicidal ideation, worsening depression, agitation, mania</li> </ul>
Sertaline (Zoloft) *Evidence based medicine supports this medication	Start daily test dose for 1-2 weeks of 12.5 mg for age 12 or sertraline 25 mg for age 12+ If test dose tolerated, increase to target daily dose of 25 mg for< age 12 or sertraline 50 mg for age 12+	<ul> <li>Common: nausea, insomnia, drowsiness, dry mouth, weight changes, sexual dysfunction</li> <li>Uncommon: increased anxiety, sweating, tremors, diarrhea</li> <li>Rare: suicidal ideation, worsening depression, agitation, mania</li> </ul>
